Your Application Dated August 8, 1990

The proposed amendment to the registration of the product cited above under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act removing the active ingredient, MGK R-11, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

1. Provide the chemical identity of all components of the perfume, H&R 4745-D. Include the Chemical Abstracts Service Registry Number and the percentage of each component in the mixture. Two copies of the Material Safety Data Sheet for the perfume must also be submitted.
2. Submit the following acute toxicity data on the new formulation. This data must be submitted within 9 months of the date of this letter.
 - a. Acute oral toxicity
 - b. Acute dermal toxicity
 - c. Acute inhalation toxicity
 - d. Primary eye irritation

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e. Primary dermal irritation

f. Dermal sensitization

Note: The first three studies may be referenced from the Dast Registration Standard.

3. Submit a 1-year storage stability study. The formulated product must be analyzed for its active ingredients at time zero and during a year of storage. The storage must be under warehouse conditions of temperature and humidity using containers similar to those which will be used in the trade. This data must be submitted within 15 months of the date of this letter.

DO NOT APPLY ON OR NEAR: acetate, rayon, spandex, Dynel or Verel fabrics, or other synthetics other than nylon. MAY DAMAGE FURNITURE FINISHES, PLASTICS, WATCH CRYSTALS, LEATHER AND PAINTED OR VARNISHED SURFACES INCLUDING AUTOMOBILES.

STORAGE: Store in a cool dry area away from heat or open flame in an area inaccessible to children.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collection.
