2. Tilt sprayer AWAY from face (container sprays straight up) Press down firmly on edge of inner sprayer until it locks into place.

PREPARATION

TO KILL ROACHES, FLEAS, TICKS, SPIDERS, FLIES, MOSQUITOES, WASPS, HORNETS, YELLOW JACKETS, SILVERFISH, ANTS, GNATS, WATERBUGS, EARWIGS, CRICKETS, and SMALL FLYING MOTHS, REMOVE or cover exposed dishes, utensils, food processing equipment and surfaces. REMOVE pets and cover or remove fish tanks and bowls. OPEN cupboards, cabinets, trunks, and doors to area to be treated. CLOSE outside doors and windows. Shut off fans and air conditioners. Extinguish all flames and pilot lights.

TO USE IN LOCKED POSITION: SHAKE BEFORE USING

1. Place Fogger on stand or table in center of room with valve locked open, placing newspaper or pad under Fogger.
2. To lock valve open: (1) Tilt sprayer AWAY from face (container sprays straight up). (2) Press down firmly on edge of sprayer until it locks into place.

3. After actuating Fogger, leave house at once and keep closed for at least two hours before airing out. Open all doors and windows and allow treated area to air for 30 minutes.

DISPOSAL

Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collection.
