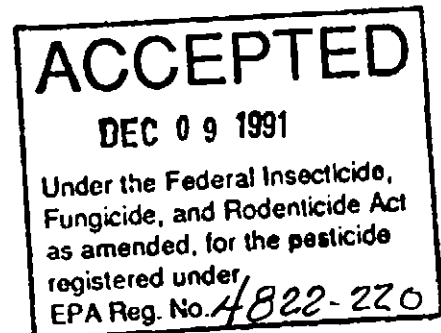

BACK PANEL

IMPORTANT: Shake well before using.

KILLS: Roaches, fleas, ticks, spiders, flies, mosquitoes, wasps, hornets, yellow jackets, silverfish, ants, gnats, waterbugs, earwigs, palmetto bugs, crickets and small flying moths. Use Raid Fogger for bug infestations in HOUSES, APARTMENTS, ATTICS AND GARAGES, restaurants, nursing homes, hospitals*, schools, homes, apartments, supermarkets, food processing plants, railroad cars, truck trailers, buses, ships, warehouses, office buildings and zoos. *Remove patients before using. After treatment ventilate rooms for two hours before returning patients to rooms.

Non-staining, fresh, clean smelling formula.

One 6 oz can treats 5000 cubic feet of unobstructed space (25'x25'x8').

Raid Indoor Fogger IV allows you to automatically fill a whole room with insect killing fog, while you are away.

Raid Indoor Fogger IV is designed for use whenever a bug infestation occurs in your house. For best results, use Raid Indoor Fogger IV in conjunction with other Raid products for more complete control of bug problems.

Preparation and Directions for Using Container:

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

- 1) Open cabinets, cupboards, drawers, closets and doors in areas to be treated. REMOVE or cover exposed foods, dishes, utensils, food processing equipment and surfaces. REMOVE pets and birds, cover and turn off fish aquariums before spraying. Turn off air flow systems in aquariums. COVER waxed wood floors, waxed furniture and stereo or other plastic dust covers in the immediate area surrounding the fogger (newspapers may be used).
- 2) CLOSE outside doors and windows. SHUT OFF fans and air conditioners. **Extinguish all flames and pilot lights.** Do not use sprayer in a cabinet or under a counter or table. Use only one can in rooms 12' X 12' or smaller.

3) Place a chair, table or stand in the center of the room to be fogged. Cover with several layers of newspaper or paper towels.

4) SHAKE CAN WELL. Break off and remove tab on side of sprayer. Tilt sprayer AWAY from face (container sprays straight up). Press down firmly on sprayer pad until it snaps into place.

5) Set fogger on covered stand. Immediately leave treated area.

6) Keep treated area closed for at least two hours. Before reoccupying area, open all doors and windows and allow treated area to air for 30 minutes.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store away from heat or open flames in an area inaccessible to children.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash. Do not puncture or incinerate.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS
HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION: Harmful if inhaled or absorbed through the skin. Avoid breathing vapors. Avoid contact with skin or clothing. Wash thoroughly after handling. Do not remain in enclosed areas after use. Stay out of rooms being treated for at least two hours. Ventilate enclosed areas before returning. Avoid contamination of food and foodstuffs. All food preparation surfaces should be covered during application and thoroughly cleaned before use. Apply only when no food is being prepared. Remove pets and birds, cover and turn off fish aquariums before spraying.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If inhaled: Remove to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated. If on skin: Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected skin areas with soap and water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Contents under pressure. Do not use or store near heat, sparks or open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperature above 130°F may cause bursting.
