The label referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA, as amended, is acceptable.

Before You Fog:

- 1) Open cabinets, cupboards, drawers, closets and doors in areas to be treated. Turn off ALL ignition sources such as pilot lights (shut off gas valves), other open flames, or running electrical appliance that cycle off and on (i.e., refrigerators, thermostats, etc.) [EPA pre-approved Pictogram 3 representing "Unplug and turn off ignition sources"]. To Start Fogging:

- 4) SHAKE CAN WELL. Break off and remove tab on side of sprayer. Tilt sprayer AWAY from face (container sprays straight up). Press down firmly on sprayer pad until it snaps into place.
- 5) Set fogger on covered stand. Vacate the treated house, individual apartment unit, or other structure immediately. Fill out and place the hang tag on the door to the treated area to alert family and others with access to the treated area not to enter for two (2) hours. Do not re-enter for two (2) hours.
