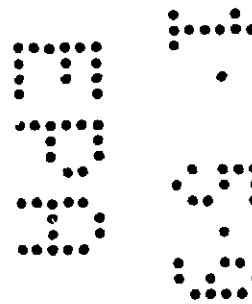

Hold as upright as possible while spraying. For outdoor use only. Not a space spray. Stand safe distance 6 to 12 feet from nest and not directly underneath. Point spray opening toward nest with wind at your back. Spray until nest is thoroughly wet. Hit wasps and hornets at rest where possible. Do not try to spray insects in flight. Best time to spray is in early morning or evening as wasps and hornets congregate nests at night. Residual action will kill wasps and hornets which return to nest. If you want to remove nest wait at least 24 hours. Do not apply to pets or contaminate feed, foodstuffs, dishes or utensils. Avoid spraying vegetation directly.

Storage and Disposal:

Storage: store in an area inaccessible to children.

Disposal: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collection.
