The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. One copy of the finished labeling must be submitted prior to releasing the product for shipment.

Remove the statement "Use only one can in rooms 12' X 12' or smaller" as this suggests that more than one can should be used in larger rooms. Using more than one can per room conflicts with statements required by PR Notice 98-6.



(For a complete flea control program, or for particularly heavy flea infestations, use Raid Fogger Formula V in conjunction with other Raid Flea Killer Plus products (Dog Spray, Yard Spray, Carpet and Room Spray).)

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

KILLS: Roaches, fleas, ticks, spiders, flies, mosquitoes, wasps, hornets, yellow jackets, silverfish, ants, gnats, waterbugs, earwigs, palmetto bugs, crickets and small flying moths. Use Raid Fogger Formula V for bug (flea) infestations in HOUSES, APARTMENTS, ATTICS AND GARAGES.

One 6 oz can treats 4600 cubic feet of unobstructed space (25'x23'x8').

Preparation and Directions for Using Container:

- 1) Open cabinets, cupboards, drawers, closets and doors in areas to be treated. REMOVE or cover exposed foods, dishes, utensils, food processing equipment and surfaces. REMOVE pets and birds, cover and turn off fish aquariums before spraying. Turn off air flow systems in aquariums. COVER waxed wood floors, waxed furniture and stereo or other plastic dust covers in the immediate area surrounding the fogger (newspapers may be used).
- 2) CLOSE outside doors and windows. SHUT OFF fans and air conditioners. Extinguish all flames and pilot lights. Do not use fogger in a cabinet or under a counter or table. Use only one can in rooms 12' X 12' or smaller.
- 3) Place a chair, table or stand in the center of the room to be fogged. Cover with several layers of newspaper or paper towels.
- 4) SHAKE CAN WELL. Break off and remove tab on side of sprayer. Tilt sprayer AWAY from face (container sprays straight up). Press down firmly on sprayer pad until it snaps into place.
- 5) Set fogger on covered stand. Immediately leave treated area.
- 6) Keep treated area closed for at least two hours. Before reoccupying area, open all doors and windows and allow treated area to air for 30 minutes.

DO NOT use more than one fogger per room. DO NOT use in small, enclosed spaces such as closets, cabinets, or under counters or tables. Do not use in a room 5 ft. x 5 ft. or smaller, instead allow fog to enter from other rooms. Turn off all ignition sources such as pilot lights (shut off gas valves), other open flames, or running electrical appliances that cycle off and on (i.e. refrigerators, thermostats, etc.). Call your gas utility or management company if you need assistance with your pilot lights.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store away from heat, sparks, and open flames in an area inaccessible to children.

DISPOSAL: Do not Puncture or Incinerate!

If empty: This container may be recycled in the few by growing number of communities where aerosol can recycling is available. If recycling is not available, wrap the container and put in trash.
