- 3. Turn on water.
- 4. When ready to spray move purple tab to ON position. (Picture)
- 5. To stop spraying when finished, or when changing areas, return tab to OFF

**DIRECTIONS: HOW TO USE-**Spray Raid Outdoor Flea Killer evenly and completely over area or plants to be treated. Hold 3 feet above surface and move at a steady pace covering approximately 20 square feet in 5 seconds. During hot weather, apply in early morning or evening when temperature is below 90 degrees. Do not use on azaleas, camelias, poinsettias, rose bushes or variegated ivy because of possible injury to these plants. Keep children and pets off of area until spray treatment dries.

**STORAGE:** Store away from heat or open flame in an area inaccessible to children.

Roaches (Water Bugs, Palmetto Bugs) & Spiders)	Around foundations, ornamental plants, and plants debris	Spray problem areas completely, covering foundations, ground adjoining foundations and all plant debris. Spray as many spiders as possible. Re-treat as necessary for control.
Chinch	Lawns	Spray lawns
