DIRECTIONS: HOW TO USE - Spray plants evenly with foam tracer. Apply to both sides of leaves and other areas of plants where insects are suspected. For dense evergreens and shrubs make sure spray reaches interior leaves and branches. Application will be more effective when air is calm. Do not spray when temperature is over 85 degrees $F$. Avoid spilling concentrated foam on grass or other plato. If spillage occurs, flush thoroughly with water. Do not use on azaleas, camellias, poinsettias, rose bushes or variegated ivy because of possible injury to these plants.
