Gypsy moth caterpillars migrate daily up and down tree trunks. Because they want to escape the heat of the sun, the caterpillars climb trees at dusk to feed at night, and descend at dawn to rest in ground cover during the day.

Raid Tree Guard System provides an insecticidal barrier. As caterpillars attempt to cross it-they pick up a lethal dose of insecticide, fall to the ground and die.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in cool dry area away from heat and open flame.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse container or band. Wrap container and band and put in trash collection.
