PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS. CAUTION: May be harmful if swallowed or absorbed through the skin. Avoid contact with eyes, skin or clothing. Wash thoroughly after handling. Avoid breathing spray mist or vapors. Keep away from food, feedstuffs and domestic water supplies. Do not allow children or pets to contact treated surface until spray has dried. Note to Physician: This product is a cholinesterase inhibitor. treat symptomatically. Atropine by injection is an antidote.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT - If Swallowed: Call a physician or Poison Control Center. Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by sticking finger down throat. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious or convulsing person.

If On Skin: Wash thoroughly with soap and water.

If In Eyes: Flush with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

ENVIRONMENTAL PRECAUTIONS: Do not apply to fish, birds, bees, or other wildlife. Do not apply to lawns, gardens, ponds, or streams. Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by application or drift or dispersal of sprays. Apply in accordance with directions on this label.

To Control Fire Ants

For Use as a Mound Treatment: Always prepare the recommended dilution. Not following directions may cause fire ants to abandon the mound and start new colonies elsewhere.

1. Remove measuring cap from top of container.

Put 3 capfuls (3 oz.) into 2 gallons of water. Rinse cap.
2. Apply 1 gallon of solution around the mound in a circle - 2 feet from the mound to cut off escape of fire ants. Use a spiral motion to wet surrounding surface up to the mound.
3. Thoroughly drench entire mound with the remaining 1 gallon of solution, slightly disturbing mound surface for deep penetration.

FOR BEST RESULTS: Treatment is most effective if applied when it's cooler (65°F-80°F), in the early morning or evening hours. Use a sprinkling can to wet mound slowly. Treat new mounds as they appear.

For Use in Sprayers, as a Whole Yard Treatment:

To achieve contact kill of the ants, they must be diluted at a rate of 3 oz. (1 capful) per 2 gallons of water. 1 2 oz. (1 1/2 capfuls) per gallon of water and apply as a coarse spray. Each gallon will cover 10 ft. x 10 ft. area (100 sq. ft.).
