DIRECTIONS FOR USE: It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

HOW TO OPERATE:

1. Attach hose to spray head coupling.
2. Turn on water.
3. When ready to spray move purple tab to on position.
4. To stop spraying when finished or changing areas, return tab to off position.

HOW TO USE:

For control of: roaches, waterbugs, crickets, silverfish, clover mites, earwigs, milipedes, sow bugs, centipedes, ants, fleas, spiders.

Apply evenly around the house foundation in a 4 to 5 foot band, on the adjoining soil, and 12 to 18 inches up on the foundation. Treat window wells, adjacent sidewalks, and patios.

Hold 3 feet above surface and move at a rate of 3 to 4 feet per second covering approximately 20 square feet in 5 seconds. Apply evenly to the entire perimeter of the home. Repeat as necessary.

Avoid spraying directly on flowers and shrubs. Use caution when using near azaleas, camellias, poinsettias, roses or variegated ivy because of possible injury to these plants. Keep children and pets out of treated area until treatment is dry.

STORAGE: Store in an area inaccessible to children.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Replace cap and discard container in trash. Do not incinerate or puncture.
