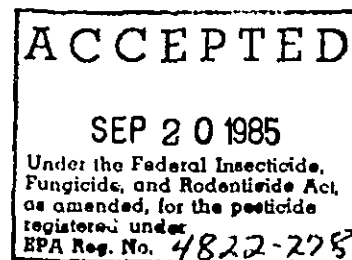

2. TREATMENT: Unwrap and keep the plastic cup and its top ring. Remove the metal insecticide cartridge from foil.
