TO KILL FLYING INSECTS

HOUSEFLIES, MOSQUITOES, SMALL FLYING MOTHS, GNATS: There is no  
need to spray directly at flying insects. Spray up into the air  
with a sweeping motion, keeping about 3 feet from interior  
walls, fabric and furniture until room is filled with mist.  
Keep room closed for 15 minutes. Ventilate room before  
reentering. Sweep up and destroy fallen insects. Repeat  
treatment as necessary.

WASPS & HORNETS: Spray directly on stray wasps and hornets that  
enter building.

TO KILL CRAWLING INSECTS

ROACHES, SILVERFISH, CRICKETS: Spray hiding places such as  
baseboards and pipes, behind bookcases, cabinets, and other  
storage areas hitting as many insects as possible. Repeat as  
necessary.

FLEAS: Remove soiled pet bedding and clean thoroughly or  
destroy. Spray sleeping quarter of pets, around baseboards,  
windows, door frames, wall cracks and floors. Spray rugs and  
carpets where flea infestations are bad. Repeat as necessary.  
Put fresh bedding in pet quarters after spray has dried. Pets  
should be treated with RAID Flea Killer before allowing them to  
return to treated area. If used on light or delicate upholstery  
fabrics. test in an inconspicuous place prior to use. For heavy  
flea infestations use RAID Flea Killer and RAID Fogger.

ANTS: Spray trails, hills, around window frames and openings,  
around pipes and baseboards where ants crawl, hitting as many as  
possible. Repeat as necessary.

SPIDERS, CENTIPEDS, SOWBUGS: Spray web and places where these insects crawl. Hit as many as possible.

CARPET BEETLES: Hit these bugs directly with spray on sections of floor baseboards, shelves, and underside of carpets. Repeat spraying at frequent intervals.

STORAGE: Store in an area inaccessible to children.

DISPOSAL: Discard container in trash.
