S.C. Johnson & Son, Inc. (SCJ) hereby notifies the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency of minor label changes to the subject product master label. 1) Changed to "Other" ingredients, 2) Changed the label statement to remove mention of a specified amount and instead list "contains sodium nitrite" as is required and referenced in the Label Review Manual, Ch. 5, VII, C. 3) Inserted "min." 0.400% ... and "max." 0.100% in the footnote which allows for the variation associated with our alternate sources of AI 4) Improve the storage statement by enhancing clarity to consumers with designation of a "cool, dry place", 5) Modified the consumer access phone number (removed the leading 1-) within the disposal section to read 800-529-3394. This is done to be consistent with the format of the other consumer access phone number located by our company name and address. 6) Added our internet address, and 7) Added "Sold by:". These changes are consistent with and meet the criteria of PR Notice 98-10, sections IV.F.8, II.N.other, II.G, and IV.F.7 (respectively), some are even considered non-notifications and we thought it convenient to also include those at this time. No other changes have been made.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Shake before using. Point spray nozzle away from face and press button, holding container as upright as possible.

TO KILL FLYING INSECTS: FLIES, MOSQUITOES, SMALL FLYING MOTHS, GNATS: With Raid® Flying Insect Killer there is no need to spray directly at flying insects - the mist in the air will kill them. Close all doors and windows. Spray Raid® Flying Insect Killer up into the air with a sweeping motion, keeping about 3 feet from interior walls, fabrics, furniture, until room is filled with mist. Keep room closed for 15 minutes. WASPS: Spray directly at stray wasps that enter building.

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TO KILL CRAWLING INSECTS: FLEAS: Spray floors, floor coverings and sleeping quarters of pets. Repeat spraying as often as necessary. CARPET BEETLES: Hit these bugs directly with spray on sections of floor, baseboards, shelves and underside of carpets. Repeat at frequent intervals. BEDBUGS: Spray baseboards, moldings, floor boards. Spray mattresses, particularly around seams and tufts. Take beds apart and spray into all joints. Repeat spraying at frequent intervals.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry area away from heat or open flame. DISPOSAL:
