FOR USE INDOORS: To kill fleas and ticks hold can 2-3 feet from surfaces to be treated. Be sure to apply thoroughly and uniformly using a sweeping motion, to rugs, carpets, drapes and all surfaces of upholstered furniture. 1) If used on light or delicate fabric, test in an inconspicuous place prior to use. Avoid wetting furniture and carpets. 2) Treat under and around furniture if pets frequently rest in these areas. Repeat as necessary. 3) Use Raid Flea Killer Plus in conjunction with Raid Fogger for particularly heavy flea infestations and for a complete flea control program.
