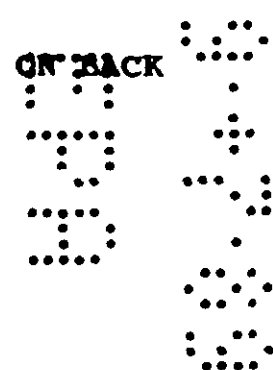

Shake well before using. Hold container upright. Point valve opening away from face and press button.

TO KILL FLYING INSECTS

FLIES, MOSQUITOES, SMALL FLYING MOTHS, GNATS, WASPS: Most effective when sprayed directly at insects. You can clear a room in minutes by spraying up into the air with a sweeping motion, keeping about 3 feet from walls, fabric and furniture until room is filled with mist. Keep room closed for 15 minutes. Ventilate room before reentering.

TO KILL CRAWLING INSECTS

FLEAS: Remove soiled pet bedding and clean thoroughly or destroy. Spray sleeping quarters of pets, around baseboards, windows, door frames and floors. Spray rugs and carpets where flea infestations are bad. Repeat as necessary. Put fresh bedding in pet quarters after spray has dried. If used on light or delicate upholstery fabrics, test in an inconspicuous place prior to use.

ROACHES, SILVERFISH, WATERBUGS: Spray hiding places such as baseboards and pipes, behind bookcases, cabinets, and other storage areas. Spray insects directly when possible. Repeat as necessary.

ANTS: Spray trails, hills, around window frames and openings, around pipes and baseboards where ants crawl. Spray insects directly when possible. Repeat as necessary.

SPIDERS, CENTIPEDES, SOWBUGS: Spray webs and places where these pests crawl. Spray insects directly when possible. Repeat as necessary.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in an area inaccessible to children.

DISPOSAL: Wrap container and put in trash.
