Raid Flying Insect Killer Formula 12
EPA Reg. No. 4822-319
Submission: October 27, 1989 and January 30, 1991


The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. Five copies of the finished labeling must be submitted prior to releasing the product for shipment.

Further review of both of your labels shows that there is an inappropriate label claim, "kills twice as fast as ordinary aerosols". CFR 156.10(a)(5)(iv) clearly states that a pesticide is misbranded if there is ... "a false or misleading comparison with other pesticides or devices".

Please remove this claim from your basic formulation label at the next reprint or within one year, whichever comes first. The claims on the alternate formulation label need to be removed prior to releasing the product for shipment.

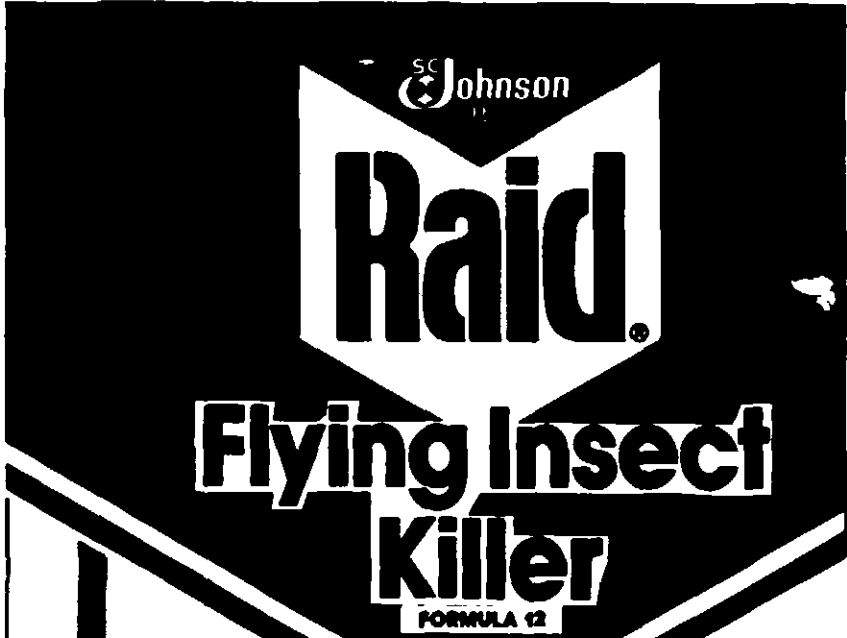
The alternate formulation requested on October 27, 1989 is accepted, but you must provide the chemical identity of all components, the percentage composition, CAS Registry Number, and Material Safety Data Sheet (two copies) for Perfume DL10613. The alternate formulation requested on January 30, 1991 is accepted. Both CSPs have been placed in your file as a matter of record.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.
 Shake well before using. Hold container upright. Point valve opening at face and press button.

TO KILL FLYING INSECTS:
FLIES, MOSQUITOES, SMALL FLYING MOTHS, GNATS: Most effective when sprayed directly at insects. You can clear a room in minutes by spraying up into the ceiling in a sweeping motion, keeping about 3 feet from walls, fabric and furniture until room is filled with mist. Keep room closed for 15 minutes. Ventilate room before reentering.
WASPS: Spray directly at stray wasps that enter building.

TO KILL CRAWLING INSECTS:
SPIDERS, CENTIPEDES, SOWBUGS: Spray webs and places where these pests hide. Spray insects directly when possible. Repeat as necessary.
ROACHES, WATERBUGS, SILVERFISH: Spray hiding places such as under boards and pipes, behind bookcases, cabinets and other storage areas. Spray directly when possible. Repeat as necessary.
ANTS: Spray trails, hills, around window frames and openings, around perimeter of baseboards where ants crawl. Spray insects directly when possible. Repeat as necessary.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL
STORAGE: Store in an area inaccessible to children.
DISPOSAL: Wrap container and put in trash.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS
HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS
CAUTION: Harmful if absorbed through the skin. Avoid contact with skin, clothing. Avoid contamination of food and foodstuffs. Remove pets, cover off pumps on fish aquariums before spraying.
STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT: In case of contact, flush skin and eyes with plenty of water. If irritation persists, consult a physician.
