

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable. A stamped copy is enclosed for your records.

As new labels are prepared, correct the precautionary statement, "Harmful is absorbed through the skin" to "Harmful if absorbed through the skin".

Your current Confidential Statement of Formula dated March 1, 1990 for the basic formulation specifies the only fragrance in the product as a "non food odor". It is therefore understood that the non-pesticidal claim --"NEW COUNTRY GARDEN FRAGRANCE"-- describes ornamental aromas, and excludes any implications to vegetables.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.
 Shake well before using. Hold container upright. Point valve opening away from face and press button.

TO KILL FLYING INSECTS

FLIES, MOSQUITOES, SMALL FLYING MOTHS, GNATS, WASPS: Most effective when sprayed directly at insects. You can clear a room in minutes by spraying up into the air with a sweeping motion, keeping about 3 feet from walls, fabric and furniture until room is filled with mist. Keep room closed for 15 minutes. Ventilate room before re-entering.

TO KILL CRAWLING INSECTS

FLEAS: Remove soiled pet bedding and clean thoroughly or destroy. Spray sleeping quarters of pets, around baseboards, windows, door frames and floors. Spray rugs and carpets where flea infestations occur. Repeat as necessary. Put fresh bedding in pet quarters after spray has dried. If used on light colored or delicate upholstery fabrics, test in an inconspicuous place prior to use.

ROACHES, SILVERFISH, WATERBUGS: Spray hiding places such as baseboards and pipes, behind book cases, cabinets, and other storage areas. Spray insects directly when possible. Repeat as necessary.

BEST AVAILABLE COPY

ANTS: Spray trails, hills, around window frames and openings, around pipes and baseboards where ants crawl. Spray insects directly when possible. Repeat as necessary.

SPIDERS, CENTIPEDES, SOWBUGS: Spray webs and places where these pests crawl. Spray insects directly when possible. Repeat as necessary.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL STATEMENTS

STORAGE: Store in an area inaccessible to children.

DISPOSAL: Wrap container and put in trash.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION: Harmful is absorbed through the skin. Avoid contact with skin, eyes and clothing. Avoid contamination of food and foodstuffs. Remove pets, cover and turn off pumps on fish aquariums before spraying.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT: In case of contact, flush skin and eyes with plenty of water. If irritation persists consult a physician.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS: Do not apply directly to water or wetlands (swamps, bogs, marshes, and potholes).

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS: Contents under pressure. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130° F. may cause bursting.
