 - b. You may add the claim "kills . . . fleas and their hatching eggs" provided the word Control is not associated with these pests. Use of the word "Control" in connection with flea larvae will require submission of data from field testing meeting the requirements of §95-11, subsection (c)(1)(ii)(B) on pages 269-270 of the Product Performance Guidelines.
 - c. The modified claims for effectiveness against resistant "fleas and roaches resistant to Baygon and Dursban" are accepted as amended. However the statements beginning "Most insecticides use chemicals . . . etc.," and ending ". . . even these tough resistant roaches and fleas" are not acceptable and must be deleted.
