Subject: Amendment - Label Revisions - Four Week Residual Claim
Raid Ant & Roach Formula 6
EPA Registration No. 4822-323
Your Application Dated January 14, 1991

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable provided that you make the labeling changes indicated below prior to release for shipment of product bearing the amended labeling.

1. The data submitted indicates that on plywood surfaces the product is not effective for a 4 week duration period. Therefore we suggest you add a qualifier indicating that "more frequent applications will be required to maintain control on plywood surfaces." An appropriate place for this statement is under Directions for Use following the sentence about excessive wetting of surfaces.

Submit five copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. A stamped copy of the labeling is enclosed for your records.

FOR HOUSEHOLD USE: Hold container upright. Do not spray up into air. Apply to surfaces only. Point spray opening toward surface to be sprayed and press button firmly. Hold about 12" from surface being sprayed. Spray until surfaces are wet. Avoid excessive wetting of asphalt, tile, rubber and plastic materials. Repeat treatment as necessary.

ROACHES, WATERBUGS: Spray until wet in cracks around baseboards and other hiding places. When bugs are driven out, spray directly.

ANTS: Apply to ant trails, also around doors, windows and wherever ants enter house.

SILVERFISH, CRICKETS, SPIDERS: Spray areas infested by these pests.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store away from heat or open flames, in an area inaccessible to children. **DISPOSAL:** Replace cap and discard in trash. Do not puncture or incinerate.
