4. The Confidential Statement of Formula (CSF) dated November 7, 1989 will not meet the label claim for the nominal concentration for the active ingredients. The upper and lower certified limits are based on the pure active ingredient rather than the technical or concentrate. Refer the PR Notice 91-2 and 40 CFR 158.175 for guidance and revised the CSF to reflect the nominal concentration of the pure active ingredient.

Raid Ant & Roach Killer₁₆ works in two ways: (1) it kills bugs fast - on contact and (2) it keeps on killing with residual action even after you sprayed for 4 weeks. Contact kill gives you immediate results when spraying individual roaches. Residual kill keeps on killing the roaches that return to the areas you have sprayed and it has a fresh outdoor scent.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

FOR HOUSEHOLD USE: Hold container upright. Do not spray up into air. Apply to surfaces only. Point spray opening toward surface to be sprayed and press button firmly. Hold about 12" from surface being sprayed. Spray until surfaces are wet. Avoid excessive wetting of asphalt tile, rubber and plastic materials. Repeat treatment as necessary.

ROACHES, WATERBUGS AND PALMETTO BUGS: For occasional bugs you see, spray directly to kill them in seconds. For thorough 12 week control, spray around baseboards, under and behind cabinets, refrigerators, sinks and other areas where bugs are seen. To maintain control, treat thoroughly every 2 to 3 months. Heavy infestations may need more frequent treatment.

ANTS: Apply to ant trails, also around doors, windows and wherever ants enter house.

SILVERFISH, CRICKETS, SPIDERS: Spray areas infested by these pests.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store away from heat or open flames in an area inaccessible to children. **DISPOSAL:** Securely wrap original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash. Do not puncture or incinerate.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS CAUTION

Harmful if swallowed. Avoid breathing spray mist. Avoid contact with skin or clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse.
