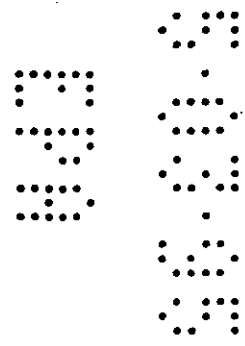

Raid Flea Killer Carpet Powder

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

TO KILL FLEAS AND FLEA LARVAE:

1. Use 4 oz. for each 100 square feet of carpet to be treated.
2. Sprinkle Raid Flea Killer Carpet Powder lightly over carpeted area by shaking container from side to side. For best results, drive the powder deep into the carpet by brushing lightly with a broom.
3. Wait one hour, vacuum as usual. Remove bag from vacuum, wrap, put in trash collection. Two or three hours may be required for severe infestation. Make sure carpet is dry before using. Do not allow powder to become wet.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in cool, dry area.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collection.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION: Harmful if absorbed through the skin. Avoid contact with skin, eyes, or clothing. Wash hands with soap and water after handling. Avoid contamination of food and foodstuffs. STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT
