On the basis of information furnished by the registrant, the above named pesticide is hereby registered/reregistered under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act.

Registration is in no way to be construed as an endorsement or recommendation of this product by the Agency. In order to protect health and the environment, the Administrator, on his motion, may at any time suspend or cancel the registration of a pesticide in accordance with the Act. The acceptance of any name in connection with the registration of a product under this Act is not to be construed as giving the registrant a right to exclusive use of the name or to its use if it has been covered by others.

This action is taken under the authority of section 4(g)(2)(c) of the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended. Reregistration under this section does not eliminate the need for continual reassessment of pesticides. EPA may require submission of data at any time to maintain the registration of your product.

Based on your response to the Reregistration Eligibility Document(s), EPA has reregistered the product listed above provided that the following change is made to the label:

- 1. The following diseases depicted on the labeling should be removed, since the agency is not permitting diseases that are currently not endemic to the United States: Japanese, Venezuelan equine, and Murray Valley mosquito borne encephalitis; European Tick Borne Encephalitis; Ross River Fever; Barmah Forest Disease; Dengue Fever; Yellow Fever; Rift Valley Fever; and; Onchocerciasis.
- 2. Within the "Hazards to Humans" section, revise the statement "Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling" to ""Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking, chewing gum, or using tobacco".
- 3. Remove the word "Skin" from the beginning of the reaction statement. The DEET RED document does not limit allergic reactions strictly to skin.

- 4. Remove the letter "s" in the reference to the term "ingredients", where it states "lower level of active ingredients. . " on your label.
- 5. The Agency is in the process of developing and improving the current Efficacy Assessment Guidelines for repellent products. The Agency intends to defer the determination of any related efficacy data requirements supporting the claims that may appear on this label until these Efficacy Assessment Guidelines are complete. When the guidelines are finalized, the Agency expects to issue a Data Call-In to address the revised guidelines to all registrants with registration for personal repellent products that have not previously submitted efficacy data sufficiently consistent with the revised guidelines.
- 6. Should you wish to add/retain a reference to the company's website on your label, then please be aware that the website becomes labeling under the Federal Insecticide Fungicide and Rodenticide Act and is subject to review by the Agency. If the website is false or misleading, the product would be misbranded and unlawful to sell or distribute under FIFRA section 12(a)(1) (E), 40 CFR 156.10(a)(5) list examples of statements EPA may consider false or misleading. In addition, regardless of whether a website is referenced on your product's label, claims made on the website may not substantially differ from those claims approved through the registration process. Therefore, should the Agency find of it is brought to our attention that a website contains false or misleading statements or claims substantially differing from the EPA approved registration, the website will be referred to the EPA's Office of Enforcement and Compliance Assurance. As an alternative, you may refer consumers to the company's phone number and email address.
