The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. Submit one (1) copy of the final printed label prior to releasing the product for shipment.

1. Correct the word "after", which appears in the CONTAINER DISPOSAL section, to read "offer".
2. The signal word CAUTION and the statement KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN should be more prominent, i.e. of a larger type size, on the product label relative to the surrounding text.
3. The ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS statement should appear on the label as follows:

This pesticide is highly toxic to fish. Do not discharge effluent containing this product into lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans, or public water unless this product is specifically identified and addressed in a NPDES permit. Do not discharge effluent containing this product into sewer systems without previously notifying the sewage treatment plant authority. For guidance, contact your State Water Board or Regional Office of the EPA.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT
