Your Submission Dated June 19, 1992

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act sec. 3(c)(7)(A), is acceptable, provided that you:

1. Submit/cite all data required for registration/reregistration of your product under FIFRA sec. 3(c)(5) when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data.
2. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:
 - a. Regarding the claims "Weather-Resistant Formula and Resists Weakening Effect of Rainfall and Sunlight": In your letter dated January 27, 1992 you stated that you would submit/reference efficacy data to support the claim. We are unaware of any efficacy data generated by Miles. Therefore the claims are unacceptable and must be deleted.
 - b. Revise imported red fire ant directions for use as follows:

To aid in control of fire ants in lawns and other outdoor home recreation areas, thoroughly drench the entire mound area. Treat all areas . . . repellency in the active mound. Apply gently to avoid disturbing ants. High pressure sprays may disturb the ants and cause migration, reducing product effectiveness. Note: For best results apply in cool weather 65-80 °F, or in early morning or late evening. ~~CONCURRENCES~~ Treat new mounds as they appear.

- c. Delete "Starter" from "Starter Kit." This implies that your product is applied in conjunction with another product/pesticide as part of a step-by-step process.

1. **Open this outer protective package.**
2. **Remove the inner insecticide packet.**
3. **Place packet into sprayer (do not open inner insecticide packet, it dissolves in water).**
4. **Add Water**
5. **Follow sprayer instructions for pumping and application.**
