Treat under and around furniture if pets frequently rest in these areas. Repeat as necessary. Use RAID® Flea Killer in conjunction with other RAID™ Flea control products for particularly heavy flea infestations and for a complete flea control program.

FOR USE IN PET AREA: Treat pet bedding and other pet resting areas as these are primary hiding areas for fleas. No need to remove pet bedding after treatment. Follow directions as for other indoor areas. For best results, pets should be treated before they return to the treated area.

FOR USE ON DOGS: To control fleas on dogs, hold can upright about 10-12 inches from pet. Spray to <u>lightly dampen</u> the animal's coat up to the head. For long-
