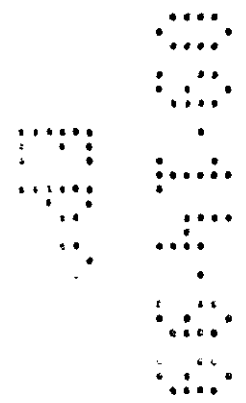

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

FOR OUTDOOR USE ONLY: To kill paper wasps, yellow jackets, mud daubers, bald-faced hornets, and bees. For best results, spray in early morning or early evening when insect activity is minimal. Stand safe distance from nest and not directly underneath. Hold can as upright as possible while spraying. Point spray opening toward nest with wind at your back. Spray until nest is thoroughly saturated to kill the entire nest population. Keeps on killing as wasps & hornets return to the nest. Wait at least 24 hours before removing the nest. Avoid spraying vegetation directly. Avoid excessive wetting of asphalt.

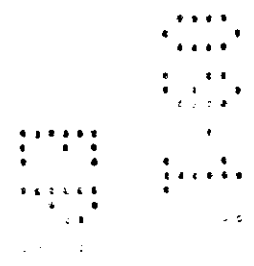
Application of the product in indoor residential settings other than as a spot treatment and/or crack and crevice is not permitted.
