e). We will allow the statement "Dry smoke leaves no residue." However, delete "no mess" and "no wet clean-up." We are not aware that spray applications leaves a wet mess or require clean-up. This is an unacceptable comparison to other products.

f). Following the sentence, "Raid Fumigator G can be used in kitchen, living areas, garages, xxx etc.", add the following statement:

"Do not use in commercial food/feed handling establishments, restaurants or other areas where food/feed is commercially prepared or processed."

Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.
