**Shake Before Using:** To kill paper wasps, yellow jackets, mud daubers, baldfaced hornets, and bees. For best results, spray in early morning or early evening when insect activity is minimal. Stand a safe distance from the nest and not directly underneath it. Hold can as upright as possible while spraying. Point spray opening toward nest with wind at your back. Spray until nest is thoroughly saturated to kill the entire nest population. Keeps on killing as wasps & hornets return to the nest. Wait at least 24 hours before removing the nest. Avoid spraying vegetation directly. Avoid excessive wetting of asphalt.

**Storage and Disposal Statements:**

**Storage:** Store in an area inaccessible to children.

**Disposal:** Do not reuse empty container. Do not puncture or incinerate. Wrap container and put in trash.
