 - a. Delete the claim "(including ticks that cause Lyme Disease)". Acceptable efficacy data must be submitted to support the addition of this claim to the product label.
 - b. Delete the terms "Unscented" and "Fragrance Free", as these terms are not appropriate claims for this product as formulated.
 - c. Please note that the Agency does not require declaration of the inert ingredients on the product label.
 - d. The Application for Pesticide Registration form which was submitted does not indicate that this product will be sold in individual, single-use pouches. Therefore, delete the statement which begins "If this product is sold..." and the "Directions for use:" declaration which specifically addresses the use of single pouches.
