- 1) Place the following statement in the First Aid section:

⌘For additional information in case of emergency call toll free(Insert phone number).⌘.

- 2) The following statements must added to the directions for use:

⌘Do not apply over cuts, wounds or irritated skin.⌘

⌘Do not allow children to handle this product.⌘

⌘Do not apply to children's hands.⌘

⌘When using on children, apply to your own hands, and then put it on the child.⌘

⌘Do not use under clothing.⌘

- 3) Add the statement, ⌘Wash treated clothing before wearing it again.⌘, to the Precautionary Statements.


This product is not being re-registered at this time. Product specific efficacy data will be required. Once the efficacy guidelines are in place, you will be notified of the efficacy requirements.

Do not keep product on any longer than necessary. After returning indoors, wash treated skin with soap and water. Do not use under clothing. Do not apply on or near: acetate, rayon, spandex, dynel fabrics or other synthetics (other than nylon), furniture, plastics, leather, watch crystals and painted or varnished surfaces including automobiles.

STORAGE: Store away from heat or flame in an area inaccessible to children.

DISPOSAL: Before disposing, empty the container by using the product according to the label. Do not reuse this container. Place in trash or offer for recycling if available.
