Dear Ms. Fugate,

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. The Agency's label notification team, has referred S.C. Johnson's proposed label modification to the Insecticides Branch for a full label review, and follow-up communications.

- 1. This acceptance does not supercede S. C. Johnson's requirement to modify the label language, as outlined in the DEET RED published by the Agency in September 1998.
- 4. 4. Section 4 "Size(s) Retail Container" lists the container size as 2-12 ounces. The last "Final Printed" label submission was received in 1995, and S.C. Johnson should update the Agency's files with current Final Printed labels for this product. [40CFR§156.10(a)(6)] The Agency also requires a print size no smaller than 6 point font [40CFR§156.10(a)(2)(A)], and a container size of 2 fl ounces, may not provide sufficient space to insure that this size criteria has been met. S.C. Johnson, Inc. should review all final printed labels' font size for this product.

Five copies of the finished labeling **must** be submitted prior to releasing the product for shipment. Since S.C. Johnson has multiple package sizes, finished labeling must be presented to the Agency for each package size. If you have any questions, you may contact Richard J. Gebken, at (703) 305-6701.
