2. Add the phrase "EPA Registration No. 4822-416" to the label prior to releasing the product for shipment.
3. Delete the following pest claim from the product label: Ticks (including ticks that cause Lyme Disease).
4. Regarding the Confidential Statement of Formula (CSF): (a) The Lower Certified Limit (column 14b) for each of the formulation components must be lower than the nominal concentration (column 13b); (b) the EPA Registration Number for the DEET source product 83401-39 is not valid. Revise the CSF and resubmit this document for the record.
5. Submit one (1) copy of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions. A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

For best results, spread evenly and completely over all exposed skin. Apply to hand for application to face and neck and rub on. Do not apply to eyes and mouth and do not apply to hands of young children. Use just enough repellent to cover exposed skin. Avoid overexposure. Frequent reapplication and saturation are unnecessary. Do not keep product on any longer than necessary. After returning indoors, wash treated skin with soap and water. Do not apply under clothing.

Do not apply on or near: acetate, rayon, spandex, dynel fabrics or other synthetics (other than nylon), furniture, plastics, leather, watch crystals and painted or varnished surfaces including automobiles.
