DIRECTIONS FOR USE: It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling FOR OUTDOOR USE ONLY.

To kill paper wasps, yellow jackets, mud daubers, bald-faced hornets, and bees. For best results, spray in early morning or early evening when insect activity is minimal. Stand safe distance from nest and not directly underneath. Hold can as upright as possible while spraying. Point spray opening toward nest with wind at your back. Spray until nest is thoroughly saturated to kill the entire nest population. Residual action will kill wasps and hornets which return to nest. Wait at least 24 hours before removing the nest. Do not apply to pets or contaminate feed, foodstuffs, dishes or utensils. Avoid spraying vegetation directly. Avoid excessive wetting of asphalt.

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STORAGE AND DISPOSAL:

Storage: Store in an area inaccessible to children.

Disposal: Do not reuse empty container. Do not puncture or incinerate. Wrap container and put in trash.

[Per PR Notice 94-2 the following Disposal statement, or a variation which does not alter its intent, may be used: Disposal: This container may be recycled in the few but growing number of communities where steel aerosol can recycling is available. Before offering for recycling, empty can by using the product according to the label. (DO NOT PUNCTURE!) If recycling is not available, do not reuse empty container.
