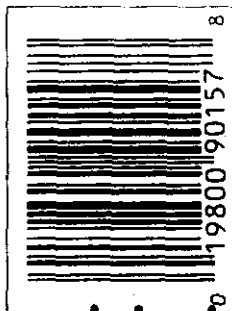

TO OPEN CHILD RESISTANT CAP: Use fingernail or coin to pull back and push down rearmost ridge of spout. Push spout down following use.

URINALS

1. Apply directly to areas A and B.
2. Squeeze Liquid VANISH onto mop applicator for about 3 seconds. Scrub all surfaces thoroughly.
3. Remove screen trap (C) to deodorize drain, and apply product 10 seconds directly on edge and into drain.
4. Wait 10 minutes, mop and flush. Rinse applicator.

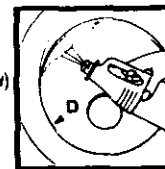
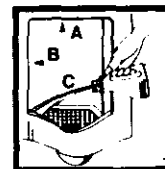
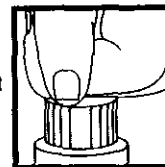
TOILET BOWLS

1. Empty water from bowl (force water over the trap with applicator).
2. Squeeze Liquid VANISH under rim (D).
3. Apply to brush for 10 seconds, scrub all areas thoroughly.
4. Wait 10 minutes, mop and flush. Rinse applicator.

TO REMOVE STUBBORN STAINS OR SCALE: Apply Liquid VANISH directly on stain, let sit 15 minutes. Mop and flush. Repeat if necessary. Liquid VANISH dissolves porous lime deposits, urine stains.
