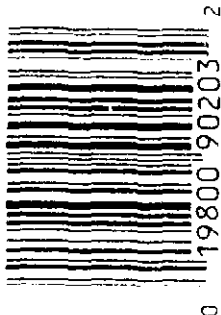
### DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

- 1.) Prewash glassware.
- 2.) Rinse with clear, cool water.
- 3.) In sanitizing tank (last tank) mix 1/4 oz. to 3 gallons of water. This provides 100ppm available chlorine for an 8 hour shift. Enclosed spoon measures 1/4 oz. Use BEER/CLEAN test strips to assure required chlorine levels. Immerse glassware for at least two minutes or for contact time specified by governing sanitary code.
- 4.) Place sanitized glassware on a rack or drainboard to air dry. (Do not towel)

Can be used in hot or cold water. Keep water temperature in compliance with local health regulations. Use clean towel to wipe each tank clean before refilling. Used as directed, last rinse will effectively act as a sanitizer against Escherichia Coli and Staphylococcus Aureus.

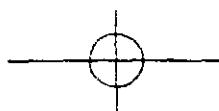
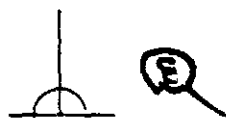
