#### **DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

FOR HOUSEHOLD USE: Hold container upright. Do not spray up into air. Apply to surfaces only. Point spray opening toward surface to be sprayed and press button firmly. Hold about 12" from surface being sprayed. Spray until surfaces are wet. Avoid excessive wetting of asphalt, tile, rubber and plastic materials. More frequent application will be required to maintain control on plywood surfaces. Repeat treatment as necessary.

FOR HOUSEHOLD USE ONLY. DO NOT USE in food processing plants, restaurants or other areas where food is commercially prepared or processed. DO NOT USE in serving areas while food is exposed. REMOVE birds and tightly cover fish bowls and aquariums in area being sprayed. Do not allow pets in treated area until spray has dried. Do not spray on plants or shrubbery.
