Dear Mr. Mendoza:

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comment below. Two (2) copies of the finished labeling must be submitted prior to releasing the product for shipment. A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

1. The Environmental Hazards statement is required, regardless of whether the product is marketed with indoor, outdoor residential or both indoor and outdoor residential uses. The Environmental Hazards are considered part of the "core" precautionary labeling and may not be modified or removed on any supplemental distributor or alternate brand name label.

EPA has determined that you have fulfilled the requirements of the Propoxur RED for the subject product. However, we are unable to reregister the product under FIFRA §4(g)(2)(c) at this time, since it contains other active ingredients (pyrethrins and piperonyl butoxide) for which reregistration eligibility decisions have not yet been made. You will be notified of the Agency's reregistration decisions for products containing these active ingredients when the REDs are completed.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

DO NOT USE AS A SPACE SPRAY. Apply to surfaces as a spot or crack and crevice treatment only. Hold container upright while spraying. Direct nozzle about 12 inches from surface to be treated. Spray away from self and other persons.

ENTRY RESTRICTIONS: Do not allow people or pets to enter the treated

area until sprays have dried.

FOR HOUSEHOLD USE ONLY. DO NOT USE in food processing plants, restaurants, or other areas where food is commercially prepared, processed or served.
