- c. Revise the NOTE TO PHYSICIAN by adding "Petroleum distillate may pose an aspiration pneumonia hazard."

A copy of the acute toxicity (precautionary labeling) reviewer's report is enclosed for your information.

3. Note that the official name of record of the product is "Raid Wasp & Hornet Killer AD." Robert B. O'Brien of S.C. Johnson verified that this name should be used, even though the word "Formula" appears in the name in some sections of the application for registration.

4. Submit two copies of the revised final printed label for the record.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

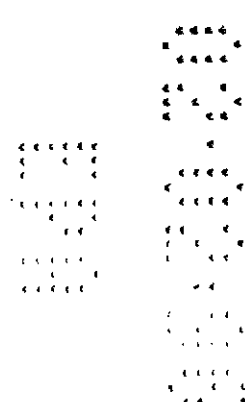

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

For outdoor use only.

Shake Before Using: To kill paper wasps, yellow jackets, mud daubers, bald-faced hornets, and bees. For best results, spray in early morning or early evening when insect activity is minimal. Stand a safe distance from the nest and not directly underneath it. Hold can as upright as possible while spraying. Point spray opening toward nest with wind at your back. Spray until nest is thoroughly saturated to kill the entire nest population. Keeps on killing as wasps & hornets return to the nest. Wait at least 24 hours before removing the nest. Avoid spraying vegetation directly. Avoid excessive wetting of asphalt.

Storage and Disposal Statements:

Storage: Store in an area inaccessible to children.

Disposal: Do not reuse empty container. Do not puncture or incinerate. Wrap container and put in trash.

[Per PR Notice 94-2 the following Disposal statement, or a variation which does not alter its content, may be used:

Disposal: This container may be recycled in the few but growing number of communities where steel aerosol can recycling is available.
