On the basis of information furnished by the registrant, the above named pesticide is hereby registered/reregistered under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act.

Registration is in no way to be construed as an endorsement or recommendation of this product by the Agency. In order to protect health and the environment, the Administrator, on his motion, may at any time suspend or cancel the registration of a pesticide in accordance with the Act. The acceptance of any name in connection with the registration of a product under this Act is not to be construed as giving the registrant a right to exclusive use of the name or to its use if it has been covered by others.

This product is unconditionally registered in accordance with FIFRA sec. 3(c)(5). Once a product is registered, however, it is not regarded as permanently acceptable. Registration does not eliminate the need for continual reassessment of pesticides. If the Agency determines that, at any time, additional data are required to maintain in effect an existing registration, the Agency will require submission of such data under FIFRA section 3(c)(2)(B).

1. Make the following label changes:

- a. Revise the EPA Registration Number to read EPA Reg. No.4822-457.
- b. Revise the Environmental Hazards statement to read as follows:  
This pesticide is toxic to birds. Do not discharge effluent containing this product into lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans, or public waters unless this product is specifically identified and addressed in an NPDES permit and the permitting authority has been notified in writing prior to discharge. Do not discharge effluent containing this product to sewer systems without previously notifying the sewage treatment plant authority. For guidance, contact your State Water Board or Regional Office of the EPA.
- c. Revise the signal word to read "Warning".
- d. Revise the Precautionary Statements to read as follows:  
May be fatal if swallowed. Harmful if absorbed through the skin or inhaled. Causes moderate eye irritation. Avoid contact with eyes, skin or clothing. Avoid breathing

vapor or spray mist. Wash hands before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco or using the toilet. Remove contaminated clothing and wash clothing before reuse.

- e. Revise the Statement of Practical Treatment (or First Aid) to read as follows:  
 If Swallowed: Call a physician or Poison Control Center. Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger, or if available by administering syrup of ipecac. If person is unconscious, do not give anything by mouth and do not induce vomiting.

If on Skin: Wash with plenty of soap and water. Get medical attention.

If inhaled: Remove victim to fresh air. If not breathing, give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth. Get medical attention.

If in eyes: Flush eye with plenty of water. Call a physician if irritation persists.

- f. You may want to add a "Note to Physician" which includes the following:
  - technical information on symptomatology;
  - use of supportive treatments to maintain life functions;
  - medicine that will counteract the specific physiological effects of the pesticide;
  - company telephone number to specific medical personnel who can provide specialized medical advice.


2. The acute dermal and 90-day subchronic toxicity studies using the technical were found unacceptable. However, these deficiencies will not affect the overall risk assessment characterization of this product since these studies were not used to determine endpoints. However, if new uses are submitted for registration, then these studies will need to be either upgraded or repeated.

3. Submit two copies of the revised final printed label for the record.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.
