Under the Federal Insorticide Fungicide, and Reducticide Ac as amended, for the posticide registered under EPA Reg. No 4822-470 Raid PP is designed for use when (a) flea infestation(s) occur(s) in your house. For a complete flea control program use Raid PP in conjunction with (other) Raid Flea Killer Plus products (Dog Spray, Fogger, Yard Spray, Carpet & Room Spray).

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

TO KILL FLEAS:

- 1. Use 8 oz. for each 100 square feet of carpet to be treated.
- 2. Make sure carpet is dry before using. Sprinkle Raid PP lightly over area by shaking container from side to side. Do not allow powder to become wet. If powder adheres to spot, brush it out and vacuum immediately. For best results, drive the powder deep into the carpet by brushing lightly with a broom.
- 3. Wait one hour, vacuum as usual. Waiting two or three hours may be required for severe infestations. Remove bag from vacuum, wrap, put in trash collection.
- 4. A second application of Raid PP 7 days late: is recommended to continue controlling severe infestations.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in cool dry area.

DISPOSAL: Before disposing, empty the container by using the product according to the label. Do not reuse this container. Place in the trash or offer for recycling if available.

If partially filled: Call your local solid waste agency or 1-800-558-5252 for disposal instructions. Never place unused product down any indoor or outdoor drain.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed. Causes moderate eye irritation. Avoid contact with eyes or clothing. Wash hands with soap and water after handling. Avoid contamination of food and foodstuffs.
