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- c. Under Precautionary Statements add "Harmful if absorbed through skin. Causes moderate eye irritation. Avoid contact with eyes, skin or clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling.".
- d. Under Precautionary Statement add "IF ON SKIN: Wash with plenty of soap and water. Get medical attention."
- e. Under Precautionary Statement add "IF IN EYES: Flush eyes with plenty of water. Call a Physician if irritation persists.".
- f. On the front label delete "Halt cockroach egg production, inhibits reproduction". Abamectin is a stomach poison and has no effect on roach reproduction.

- i. Delete the statement/phrase for placing baits on kitchen countertops. This statement is in conflict with keeping out of reach of children. Also the Agency does not recommend use of insecticides directly on food contact surfaces.
- j. On the front panel revise the phase "xx helping to rid your home of xxx etc." to "protecting your home from roaches xxx". Claims such as rid, 100% control are unacceptable.

The acute toxicity data submitted in support of EPA Registration Number 499-294 is acceptable in support of this product formulation. We grant your request for a waiver for acute inhalation toxicity data since the subject product does not produce an inhalable material.
