DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

[For Household use only]

For most effective results, entire premises should be treated. Use one 6 oz. unit for up to 5,000 cubic feet (approximately 25' x 25' x 8' ceiling) of unobstructed space.

Preparation and Directions for Using Container:

1) Open cabinets, cupboards, drawers, closets and doors in areas to be treated. REMOVE or cover exposed foods, dishes, utensils, food processing equipment and surfaces. Clean thoroughly before reuse. Do not smoke while using. REMOVE pets, birds, and remove or cover and turn off fish aquariums before spraying. Turn off air flow systems in aquariums. COVER waxed wood floors, waxed furniture and stereo or other plastic dust covers in the immediate area surrounding the fogger (newspapers may be used).

2) CLOSE outside doors and windows. SHUT OFF fans and air conditioners. Extinguish all flames and pilot lights. Do not use fogger in a cabinet or under a counter or table. Turn-off electrical equipment in area being treated. Use only one can in rooms 12' X 12' or smaller. Do not use this unit in an area less than 100 cubic feet.

3) Place a chair, table or stand in the center of the room to be fogged. Cover with several layers of newspaper or paper towels.

4) SHAKE CAN WELL. Break off and remove tab on side of sprayer. Tilt sprayer AWAY from face (container sprays straight up). Press down firmly on sprayer pad until it snaps into place.

5) Set fogger on covered stand. Immediately leave treated area and close door.

6) After activating fogger, leave room or house at once. Keep treated area closed for at least two hours. Before reoccupying area, open all doors and windows and allow treated area to air for 30 minutes. Repeat treatment as necessary.

Do NOT use more than one fogger per room. DO NOT use in small, enclosed spaces such as closets, cabinets, or under counters of tables. Do not use in a room 5 x 5 ft. or smaller, instead allow fog to enter from other rooms. Turn off all ignition sources such as pilot lights (shut off gas valves), other open flames, or running electrical appliances that cycle on and off (i.e. refrigerators, thermostats, etc.). Call your gas utility or management company if you need assistance with your pilot lights.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in a cool dry area away from heat, sparks and open flame, in an area inaccessible to children.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash.
