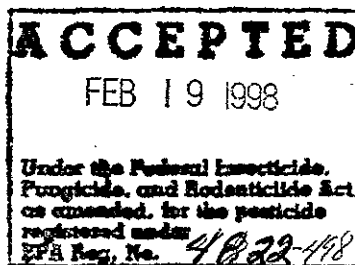

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF ON SKIN: Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas with soap and water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: If symptoms of cholinesterase inhibition are present, atropine sulfate is antidotal. 2-PAM is also antidotal and may be administered in conjunction with atropine.

Chlorpyrifos [0,0-Diethyl O-(3,5,6-Trichloro-2-Pyridyl) Phosphorothioate]0.5%

INERT INGREDIENTS:99.5%

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DIRECTIONS FOR USE

IT IS A VIOLATION OF FEDERAL LAW TO USE THIS PRODUCT IN A MANNER INCONSISTENT WITH ITS LABELING.

Outdoor Treatments

FIRE ANTS: To treat nests, insert injector into the nest full length if possible. Inject the nest at 3-6 sites at a rate of 5-10 seconds per site. For very large nests (over 36" diameter), increase the number of injection sites. Space injection sites in a circular pattern on the nest surface with one site in the center. To quiet active ants on nest service, sweep surface with spray from a distance of 12 inches. For best results, apply when temperature is 65-85°F, or in early morning or late evening hours. Treat new nests as they appear.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

STORAGE: Store in a cool dry area away from heat or open flame and inaccessible to children.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Wastes resulting from use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Replace cap and discard container in trash, sanitary landfill or by other approved state and local procedures. Do not incinerate or puncture. This container may be recycled in the few but growing number of communities where steel aerosol can recycling is available. Before offering for recycling, empty the can by using the product according to the label. (DO NOT PUNCTURE). If recycling is not available, wrap the container and discard in the trash.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS
