1. Remove coils from (pouch) (all wrapping materials) (container) (box) (envelope).
2. (Loosen outer rings until end moves freely.)
(Grasp each COMMA shaped portion in the center between thumb and forefinger of each hand.)
(Separate the two COMMA shaped portions by gently pressing them in opposite direction 1/4 inch apart.)
3. Align coil with mounting (detail) (stand) (device) (tray). Insert (press) (mount) snap the slot of the coil onto (into) the metal stand in the base of the pot.
4. Light outer end of coil until glowing, then BLOW OUT ANY FLAME.
5. Restore lid (slide tray and into unit) (align lid to base) (snap lid to base) and place unit (pot) (device) (coil) 6-10 (8-10) feet apart around area to be protected. Each coil lasts (up to) (2) (3) (4) (5) (6) (7) (8) (9) (2-3) (5-7) hours.
6. If shorter period of use is desired, carefully lift coil out of pot and extinguish (snuffing into the pot) (by pressing the glowing end inside the pot). The unused portion can then be relit when needed.

7. (Save the pot for use with SNAKE II refills.) (When repellent coil is completely (exhausted) (used), save the pot for future use with SNAKE II refills.)

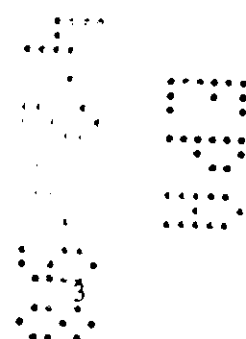

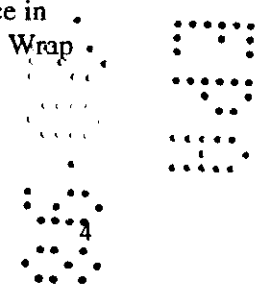

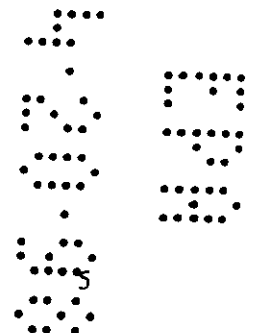
