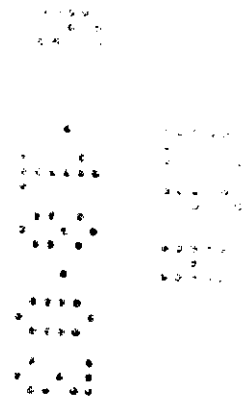

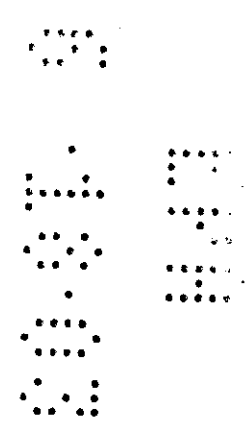

Directions for Use

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Break (baits) (bait stations) (Raid Double Control Ant Baits) apart from the plastic frame before placement.

Place (baits) (bait stations) (Raid Double Control Ant Baits) by ant trails or close to areas where ants are present, even on food preparation surfaces or next to food. Do not place (baits) (bait stations) (Raid Double Control Ant Baits) on food preparation surfaces when food is being handled or on utensils that are used for food preparation. Also place adjacent to walls, electrical lines, potted plants, waste receptacles, sensitive electronic equipment, inside drop ceilings and wall voids or anywhere ant problems occur. (To apply (baits) (bait stations) (Raid Double Control Ant Baits) to vertical surfaces, use the enclosed stickers.)

Do not use residual sprays *on* or near (baits) (bait stations) (Raid Double Control Ant Baits).

Ants will begin to feed -- population reduction and less activity can be expected in about a week.

For effective control:

Use 3-4 (baits) (bait stations) (Raid Double Control Ant Baits) for the average size room.

Use more (6-8) for heavy infestations.


The purpose of this notification is to add parentheses to the currently approved text, "Contains Sulfluramid, that keeps killing ants continuously for up to three months" in order to allow revision of the claim to, "Keeps killing ants continuously for up to 3 months." I have highlighted the parentheses in bold italics on page two of the label for your reference.

This notification is consistent with the provisions of PR Notice 98-10 and EPA regulations at 40 CFR 152.46, and no other changes have been made to the labeling or confidential statement of formula of this product. I understand that it is a violation of 18 U.S.C. Sec. 1001 to willfully make any false statement to EPA. I further understand that if this notification is not consistent with the terms of PR Notice 95-2 and 40 CFR 152.46, this product may be in violation of FIFRA and I may be subject to enforcement action and penalties under sections 12 and 14 of FIFRA.
