Directions for Use:

This statement will only be used if a thermal seal is used on the top of the container:

- Unscrew cap, remove liner, and replace cap tightly before use.
- Sprinkle evenly onto carpet, about 1/4 cup (or) (70g) (2.5oz) per square yard. One (canister)(pouch) will cover 6' x 10' area.
- Allow powder to penetrate into (remain on) the carpet for 30 minutes.
- Vacuum thoroughly.

For best results on medium to heavy pile carpets, first brush the powder into the carpet with a broom using light strokes, leave for 30 minutes, then vacuum.

Keep children and pets off treated areas during application and until area is vacuumed.

For best results repeat treatment at least every 2 to 4 weeks.
