

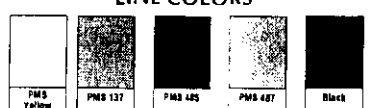

Re: RAID REK, EPA Reg. No. 4822-529  
Notification of Added Label Text

This is to notify the Agency that we wish to add: (a) our website address, "[www.killsbugsdead.com](http://www.killsbugsdead.com)" (b) the word "**INFESTATIONS**" to be used interchangeably with the word "problems" in the approved claim "(Relief from) (Use) (For) (even) severe ant (problems)(**INFESTATIONS**)" and (c) "**1. Ants crawl in to eat. 2. Crawl away to die.**" to subject label. This last claim is simply a restatement of the already approved advisory statements on page two of the text label ("Ants are attracted to the bait in [Product Name]. The food is carried back to the nest to destroy the entire colony") and so should present no problem. I am attaching a copy of the text label with these minor additions, as well as a copy of the final printed label, for your reference and records.

This notification is consistent with the provisions of PR Notice 98-10 and EPA regulations at 40 CFR 152.46, and no other changes have been made to the labeling or the confidential statement of formula of this product. I understand that it is a violation of 18 U.S.C. Sec. 1001 to willfully make any false statement to EPA. I further understand that if this notification is not consistent with the terms of PR Notice 98-10 and 40 CFR 152.46, this product may be in violation of FIFRA and I may be subject to enforcement action and penalties under sections 12 and 14 of FIFRA.
