This is to notify the Agency that we wish to add a graphic and related text advising the consumer to "Twist and snap off tab before spraying." I am attaching a copy of the text label with this sentence added, as well as a copy of the final printed label (for the alternate brand name, "Raid Earth Options Wasp & Hornet Killer") for your reference and records. I believe this change is related solely to packaging and involves no changes to dosage, concentration, frequency or method of application, or exposure. This product is not a rodenticide or bait, and does not require CR packaging. Therefore I believe this notification is appropriate under Section 2. E. of PR Notice 98-10.

This notification is consistent with the provisions of PR Notice 98-10 and EPA regulations at 40 CFR 152.46, and no other changes have been made to the labeling or the confidential statement of formula of this product. I understand that it is a violation of 18 U.S.C. Sec. 1001 to willfully make any false statement to EPA. I further understand that if this notification is not consistent with the terms of PR Notice 98-10 and 40 CFR 152.46, this product may be in violation of FIFRA and I may be subject to enforcement action and penalties under sections 12 and 14 of FIFRA.







For Tent Caterpillars: Apply when caterpillars are young and tents are first noticed. For best results apply in late afternoon or evening when caterpillars have returned to their tent. Aim spray directly at tent and apply until saturated.
