The Agency is in receipt of your Application for Pesticide Notification under Pesticide Registration Notice (PRN) 98-10 for the above referenced product. The Registration Division (RD) has conducted a review of this request for its applicability under PRN 98-10 and finds that the action requested falls within the scope of PRN 98-10.

The alternate brand name "*OFF! FamilyCare Insect Repellent VIII*" has been added to the product record.

The label submitted with the application has been stamped "Notification" and will be placed in our records.

Should you wish to add/retain a reference to the company's website on your label, then please be aware that the website becomes labeling under the Federal Insecticide Fungicide and Rodenticide Act and is subject to review by the Agency. If the website is false or misleading, the product would be misbranded and unlawful to sell or distribute under FIFRA section 12(a)(1)(E). 40 CFR 156.10(a)(5) list examples of statements EPA may consider false or misleading. In addition, regardless of whether a website is referenced on your product's label, claims made on the website may not substantially differ from those claims approved through the registration process. Therefore, should the Agency find or if it is brought to our attention that a website contains false or misleading statements or claims substantially differing from the EPA approved registration, the website will be referred to the EPA's Office of Enforcement and Compliance.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. **Read and follow all directions and precautions on this product label.**

Shake well before using. Hold container 6 to 8 inches from skin and spray with a slow sweeping motion. Do not apply over cuts, wounds, irritated or sunburned skin. Do not spray in enclosed areas. Use just enough repellent to cover exposed skin. Do not use under clothing. Avoid over-application of this product. Reapply every 6 hours. Frequent reapplication and saturation are unnecessary. Do not apply more than three times per day. On young children, do not apply more than twice in a day. Do not allow children to handle this product. After returning indoors, wash treated skin with soap and water. FOR MAXIMUM PROTECTION, spread evenly with hands to moisten all exposed skin.

TO APPLY TO FACE: Spray palm of hand first and then apply sparingly and avoid eyes. Do not spray directly onto face. Do not apply near eyes and mouth. Apply sparingly around ears. Do not apply to children's hands. When using on children, apply to your own hands and then put it on the child.

STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry place away from heat, sparks and open flame.

DISPOSAL: Do not puncture or incinerate!
